The Biodiversity Management Bureau (BMB) is the lead agency mandated to conserve and protect the country's biological diversity as well as to sustainably manage important resources and ecosystem services they provide. # VI. MANAGING THE NINOY AQUINO PARKS AND WILDLIFE CENTER

The Bureau manages the 23.85-hectare Ninoy Aquino Parks and Wildlife Center (NAPWC). For the  $4^{th}$  Quarter of CY 2021, the Park still managed to earn income amounting to Php1,802,565.05 wherein Php1,061,410 came from the entrance fees of 39,574 visitors (male=18,514; female=21,060), Php 190,660.00 from parking fees, Php 369,260.05 from facilities rented and Php181,235.00 from other activities in the park.
