TERMS OF REFERENCE

PROCUREMENT OF CONSULTANCY SERVICES AS INSTITUTIONAL DEVELOPMENT SPECIALIST FOR THE DENR-UNDP/GEF PROJECT ON INTEGRATED APPROACH IN MANAGEMENT OF MAJOR BIODIVERSITY CORRIDORS IN THE PHILIPPINES OR BD CORRIDOR PROJECT

I. Background

The Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), with funding from the Global Environment facility (GEF) and support from the United Nations Development Program (UNDP), is implementing the project entitled "Integrated Approach in Management of Major Biodiversity Corridors in the Philippines" or BD Corridor. The Project aims to operationalize integrated management of biodiversity corridors to generate multiple benefits including effective conservation of globally threatened species and high conservation value forests, reduce deforestation and degradation and enhance local biodiversity-friendly livelihoods. This Project has four components, namely:

- Component 1: Effective coordination and governance framework for integrated ecosystem management in the Philippines biodiversity corridors system;
- Component 2: Application of integrated network design and management of biodiversity corridors to ensure continued stability and sustainability of their biological, ecosystem services and socio-economic conservation values;
- Component 3: Community-based sustainable use and management systems in the two pilot biodiversity corridor systems in the Philippines; and
- Component 4: Knowledge management, gender mainstreaming, learning, monitoring and evaluation.

II. Objective

The objective of this Consultancy is to prepare and finalize policies related to the operationalization of Integrated Ecosystems Management (EIM) at the National and Corridor levels.

III. Scope of Work

The scope of work of this Terms of Reference is beyond the optimum in-house capability of the procuring entity and is consistent with the Government's policy not to compete with the private sector as integrated in Item 2 of Annex "B" of the 2016 Implementing Rules and Regulation of RA 9184.

Specifically, the scope of services is as follows:

- 1. Building on work of the Institutional Development Specialist in 2022, draft and finalize the following policies to support operationalization of IEM:
 - a. Draft DENR Administrative Order re Guidelines on the HCV-Based IEM Approach in Environment and Natural Resources (ENR) Plans and Programs as a DA-DENR-DILG-NCIP Joint Administrative Order (JAO);

- b. Regional Development Council (RDC) Resolution Creating CAACs for Reg 11 and 13 (EMBC)/ Reg 4B (MBC);
- c. Draft Guidelines on Other Effective Area-based Conservation Measures (OECMs), including Indigenous and Conserved Conservation Areas (ICCAs), Local Conservation Areas, Reference Ecosystems, Conservation Estates, etc.
- d. Amendment to DENR DAO 2003-30 and its Procedural Manual, including EMB MC 2014-015 on Guidelines for Covering Screening and Standardized Requirements under the PEISS, particularly in relation to biodiversity and extractive industries.
- e. Amendment to DENR DAO 2022-04 to integrate recent developments and feedbacks from DENR Field Offices and mining companies
- 2. Review of policies, programs, plans and related frameworks, and start discussions on the following:
 - a. Enhancement of the Philippine Code for Good Agricultural Practice (PhilGAP) / Philippine National Standards (PNS);
 - b. Guidelines on Enhancing Biodiversity Conservation and Protection Measures in Small Scale Mining Operations.
- 3. Review and provide technical assistance in the preparation and finalization of the Joint DENR-DILG-DHSUD Administrative Order on Mainstreaming Biodiversity and IEM into the CLUP and CDP;
- 4. Finalize the JAO of DENR-DILG and DHSUD on Mainstreaming Biodiversity and IEM into the CLUP and CDP;
- 4. Act as Resource person during presentation of outputs/deliverables to NPB and TWG, and other events, and participate in policy discussions relevant to the Project;
- 5. Coordinate with other project consultants and other offices, as maybe necessary, in the review and finalization of outputs and deliverables; and,
- 6. Perform other related tasks as may assigned by the National Project Director and National Project Manager.

- 4. Experience working local government units, DILG and other government agencies
- 5. Experience with GEF and /or UN- assisted projects would be an advantage

The Consultant is expected to deliver the outputs within ten (10) months after acceptance of Notice to Proceed (NTP).
