TERMS OF REFERENCE

Implementing the National Framework on Access and Benefit Sharing of Genetic Resources and Associated Traditional Knowledge in the Philippines

PROCUREMENT OF A VIDEO CONSULTING TEAM/FIRM FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE ABS PROJECT'S AVPs AND VIDEO EXPLAINER

A. Background and Rationale

The GEF-UNDP-DENR Project on Implementing the National Framework on Access and Benefit Sharing of Genetic Resources and Associated Traditional Knowledge in the Philippines or the Access and Benefit Sharing Project (ABS Project) is a 6-year Global Environment Facility (GEF) funded project implemented by the DENR-BMB with support from the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP).

The Project aims to strengthen the implementation of the Nagoya Protocol (NP) in the Philippines by strengthening the national Access and Benefit Sharing (ABS) framework, building national and local capacities through capacity-building and awareness-raising activities and developing critical experience in ABS agreements. The project seeks to increase economic opportunity and biodiversity conservation for local communities and indigenous peoples in the Philippines stemming from the fair and equitable sharing of biodiversity benefits through three main components.

In accordance with the Project's Communication Strategy and Plan, as well as its Communication, Education, and Public Awareness (CEPA) campaign, producing informative audio-visual presentations and video explainers are needed for campaign awareness and to improve the Project's perceived value to its key stakeholders and the public. These will be shared in DENR-BMB and UNDP websites and social media pages and will be shared with stakeholders during seminars, workshops, and conferences.

The result of this engagement will directly support the Project in achieving Project Results Indicator 8 (Gender-responsive and culture-sensitive CEPA plan); and will directly contribute to realizing Project Output 2.1 (Awareness campaign targeted to different ABS stakeholders).

B. Objective and Scope of Work

The Project intends to engage the services of a video consulting team/firm to: (i) develop a 7-minute full and a 2-minute cut audiovisual presentations on the ABS Project; (ii) develop a 3-minute animated video explainer and three 30-second short clips on ABS.

The audio-visual presentations will showcase an overview of the Project's background and rationale, outputs/outcomes, and targets for the next 6 years of implementation. The animated video explainer and 30-second short clips will provide an engaging explanation on the concept of access and benefit sharing of the Nagoya Protocol in the Philippine context.

The scope of work of this Terms of Reference is beyond the optimum in-house capability of the procuring entity and is consistent with the Government's policy not to compete with the private sector as integrated in Item 2 of Annex "B" of the 2016 Implementing Rules and Regulation of RA 9184.

C. Detailed Tasks

The video consulting team/firm will work closely with the ABS Project Management Unit in close collaboration with the Communications Officer, and will be responsible for the following tasks:

This is an output-based engagement. The video consulting team/firm will not be required to report regularly or be present at the Project's office during the contract period but will be requested to attend meetings and report to the Project regarding progress as necessary.

D. Deliverables/Expected Outputs

This engagement will be for a period of six (6) months, commencing upon signing of the contract.

- 1. Approved overall concept, storyboard, and script for the 3-minute animated video explainer and three (3) 30-second short clips on ABS;
- Final 3-minute animated video explainer and three (3) 30-second short clips on ABS in MP4 format;
- Approved overall concept, storyboard, and script for the 7-minute and 2-minute AVPs of the ABS Project
- 4. One final 7-minute and a 2-minute AVPs on the ABS Project in MP4 format;
- 5. All edited and RAW materials -- high definition video footages, still photos, recorded sound and narration, graphics and animation -- must be submitted; and
- 6. Signed consent and release form of all interviewees and respondents.

Note: DENR-BMB retains full rights of all materials and footage (RAW and edited) in this production. Still photos should be submitted to BMB immediately after production shoot at each project site.

E. Minimum Qualification Requirements

- 1. The video consulting team/firm should have the following qualifications:
 - Has at least 3 years of experience in producing audiovisual presentations and animated video explainers with preference given to those who have produced videos on biodiversity for government or non-government organizations;
 - Has at least 4 sample high quality audiovisual presentations and animated video explainers
 produced for government agencies, non-government and academic institutions involved in
 the biodiversity/natural resources/economic/social and development sectors; and
 - Has at least 2 years proven experience working with DENR, GEF, and UNDP, or other international organizations.

F. Method of Evaluation

Applicants will be evaluated using Quality-Based Evaluation (QBE) based on RA 9184 and its IRR which will only consider a sample of works in the ranking of consulting firms.

G. Budget, Reporting and Payment Schedule

A total payment of **Php 512,000** is allocated for the procurement to cover preparation work, equipment, supplies, and materials, travel costs, meetings, professional fees of the team including additional cameraman, assistants and voice over artist/s, conduct of all activities, and overall production and packaging of the final videos, among others.

The video consulting team/firm is expected to bear the costs of equipment, editing tools, and materials (video cameras, microphones, audio recorders, drones, tripods, data storage devices, etc) in the conduct of this engagement.

The payment to the video consulting team/firm is made in tranches after the submission and acceptance of the expected outputs. Processing of payment will be done through DENR-BMB, and direct payment will be made by UNDP Philippines.
