CONTEXT & BACKGROUND

The Philippines is one of the world's 17 megadiverse countries, which collectively host two-thirds of the earth's biodiversity. It harbors one of the highest concentrations of unique wildlife species in the world. Yet, it is also a biodiversity hotspot, with habitat loss and illegal wildlife trade (IWT) considered to be two of the biggest threats to species survival.

Over the last decade, the Philippines has become an important source, transit, and destination point for IWT, estimated to be worth ₱50 billion a year (roughly equivalent to \$1 billion), which includes the market value of wildlife and its resources, their ecological role and value, damage to habitats incurred during poaching, and loss in potential ecotourism revenues.

Wildlife Agency and Citizen Law Enforcement Reporting Tool or WildALERT is a tool developed to help field enforcers identify wildlife species commonly poached and trafficked in the Philippines. This serves as a reporting platform for private citizens and government officials to alert the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) about activities or incidents on illegal wildlife trade in the country.

OBJECTIVES

WildALERT is an innovative solution that aims to improve the daily enforcement operations of DENR and partner agencies by providing a real-time and centralized platform for reporting of wildlife crimes.

WildALERT Platform contains a library with 575 species (485 animals and 95 plant

WildALERT Platform contains a library with 575 species (485 animals and 95 plants) their photos, scientific name, and common names in English, Filipino, and local dialects. It also lists the geographic distribution, description, and conservation status of each species.

The DENR-Asian Development Bank/Global Environment Facility (ADB/GEF) Project supported the flora component in the species library, while United States Agency for International Development (USAID) Protect Wildlife Project supported the development of the system and its fauna component.

FEATURES OF THE PLATFORM

WildALERT has a public website, customer relationship management (CRM) platform, and mobile android application that you can use to report. WildALERT CRM platform helps DENR-BMB organize and manage website data and reports to improve stakeholder engagement and website services. While WildALERT mobile application can be downloaded via Google Play Store.

The website has (1) library of wildlife flora and fauna species commonly poached or trafficked in the country, (2) frequently asked questions on wildlife species and illegal wildlife trade, (3) glossary of terms commonly used to describe species or used in wildlife trade/protection/management, (4) link where you can download the mobile application, and (5) contact details of the closest DENR office that you can reach out to inquire or report.

The six (6) main functions of the application are the following

- Search species feature allows users to search species using certain keywords (either English name or category under which species belong);
- Manage Data feature allows users to update the flora and fauna species in the database and update the Quick Contact section;
- Quick contacts feature lists all Regional Executive Director (RED) or Officersin-Charge (OIC) name, designation contact number, and office address by region;
- Help Section provides additional information on how to set-up the app frequently asked questions, and glossary of wildlife terms; and
- Report feature allows app users to submit illegal wildlife trade reports with narrative (report data), geo-tagged report, upload photos from mobile device, enable auto-date and time for the report, draft the report offline, save report to mobile application, and submit it online.

- a. Report -> Web Customer Relationship Management (CRM): A report generated from the mobile will be sent to the Website CRM in real-time.
- b. Identify -> Species Identification: When identifying a species, the user must go to characteristics of the species. and narrow down the selection based on the Species Identification feature of the application








Figure 1.1. WildALERT website system flow.

- c. Feedback -> My Report Logs: When checking the status/feedback of the user's report, the user will be redirected to the CRM and will require credentials to access the user's reports.
- d. Inquiry -> Contact Us: For inquiries, the user can access the list of directories from all regions




Figure 1.2. System flow after a report is submitted.

Second-level system flow after a report has been submitted is shown in Figure 1.2. Whenever a user sends a report, the National and Regional will be able to view the report and add comment or follow up any concerns on the report. Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office (PENRO) and Community Environment and Natural Resources Office (CENRO) are authorized to categorize, verify, and identify the response level of each report submitted by the user.





Figure 1.3. System flow on categorizing and identifying response level.

Third-level system flow on how to categorize and identify response level is shown in Figure 1.3. The PENRO and CENRO must categorize the report. If YES, CENRO will decide if the report needs immediate action. If the 2nd YES is chosen, CENRO will have the option to change the status
