Subject : Scope of Works and Technical Specifications

Item I. SITE PREPARATION/MOBILIZATION & DEMOBILIZATION

The works under this item shall include the transportation of needed materials, labor and equipment from legal sources to the project site for the Supply and Installation of Submersible Aerator/Aerating Fountain for official use of NAPWC in support to its Lagoon Rehabilitation located inside the park in Quezon Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City. Aforesaid activities shall be done carefully and properly as directed. For other details, please refer to the approved plans/drawings.

Item II. EXCAVATION WORKS/CLEARING

The works under this item shall include the preparation of the lay-out of the plans and excavation of the area for the placement of the aerator and its accessories. Aforesaid activities shall be done carefully and properly as directed. The volume of the excavation to be done will depend on the dimensions of the aerator and its accessories. The project site shall be cleared of all debris/wastes, obstructions and other objectionable matters as directed.

Item III. INSTALLATION OF SUBMERSIBLE AERATOR/AERATING FOUNTAIN

The works under this item shall include the proper installation of Submersible Aerators/Aerating Fountains. Proper positioning of the aerators and its accessories should be based according to the plans and drawings or as directed. For other details, please refer to the approved plans/drawings.



Item IV. LIGHTING DESIGN PROVISIONARY

The works under this item shall include the proper installation of Lighting Design Provisionary. This includes the wirings, sockets and other electrical accessories for the installed aerator. The installed lighting design will serve as provisionary which will be altered in the future. All installations to be done should be based according to the approved plans and drawings or as directed.

Item V. CLEARING & TURN-OVER

The works under this item shall include the proper disposal of debris/wastes, obstructions and other objectionable matters in the site and the turn-over of the project. After clearing the site of debris, strict site inspection will be conducted for proper turn-over. Turn-over will be denied if the project is incomplete or there are defects/problems in the project. Project will be completed after turn-over.


