BAC RESOLUTION AND RECOMMENDING APPROVAL RESOLUTION NO. 2023-220

Resolution Declaring the Highest Rated Bidder for the

Procurement of Consultancy Firm for the Formulation of Corridor Management Plans for the Biodiversity Corridors Project

WHEREAS, the Biodiversity Management Bureau (BMB) conducted a public bidding for the *Procurement of Consultancy Firm for the Formulation of Corridor Management Plans for the Biodiversity Corridors Project* and posted the requirement in the Philippine Government Procurement System (Phil-GEPS), BMB Website, and Bulletin Board with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of **Ph30,000,000.00**:

WHEREAS, in response to the posting, four (4) bidders submitted eligibility documents on or before the deadline on 01 June 2023, to wit:

- 1. Geographic Innovations for Development Solutions, Inc. (GRIDS)
- 2. Planning and Development Research Foundation, Inc., (PLANADES)
- 3. CPRM Consultants, Inc.,
- 4. Center for Environmental Law and Policy Advocacy, Inc. CELPA

WHEREAS, in the evaluation of Eligibility Requirements, two (2) consulting firms were rated "Passed" based on the approved Shortlisting Criteria per BAC Resolution No. 2023-138 dated June 15, 2023; to wit:

- 1. Center for Environmental Law and Policy Advocacy, Inc. CELPA
- 2. Planning and Development Research Foundation, Inc., (PLANADES)

WHEREAS, after the eligibility check and shortlisting procedure, the two (2) shortlisted consulting firms were invited for a Pre-bid Conference on 25 July 2023 to discuss the Scope of Work in detail;

WHEREAS, during the opening of technical proposals on 11 August 2023, the two (2) shortlisted firms were rated "Passed" based on the non-discretionary "PASS-FAIL" criterion on the absence or presence of documents of the checklist included in the bidding documents;

WHEREAS, the Technical Working Group scrutinized and evaluated the documents submitted by the two (2) Consulting Firms based on the prescribed Technical Criteria using Quality Based Evaluation Procedure (QBE) with a passing score of not lower than 70%;

WHEREAS, after evaluation of the technical documents, the BAC concurred with the scoring made by the Technical Working Group, the results and ranking are as follows:

WHEREAS, based on the above evaluation, *Center for Environmental Law and Policy Advocacy, Inc. CELPA* garnered a higher score of 87.29% than its competitor, making it the highest rated firm for the above-mentioned project;

NOW, THEREFORE, We the members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED:

- 1. To declare *Center for Environmental Law and Policy Advocacy, Inc. CELPA* as the *Highest Rated Firm* and proceed with the opening of their financial proposal;
- 2. To carry on with the negotiation process with *Center for Environmental Law and Policy Advocacy, Inc. CELPA*
- 3. To recommend the foregoing findings for approval of the OIC, Director of the Biodiversity Management Bureau
