SUBJECT: 1990 QUOTA FOR CERTAIN WILDLIFE SPECIES THAT MAY BE COLLECTED FROM THE WILD UNDER A WILDLIFE PERMIT FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES.

Pursuant to the provisions of Act No. 2590 as amended, Presidential Decree No. 705 as amended, and Executive Order No. 192 dated June 10, 1987, in furtherance of the provisions of DENR AO 90 and 96, Series of 1988 and in consonance with the sustainable resource development policy of the Department, and to effectively protect the endangered, rare, and threatened Philippine wildlife, and support the covenants of the Convention on Interantional Trade in Endangered Species (CITES), the following allowable quota by species for collection from the wild under a wildlife permit for comercial purposes are hereby established and promulgated for the information and guidance of all concerned.
