**SUBJECT : SUPPLEMENTARY GUIDELINES FOR THE CONDUCT OF  
SURVEY, MAPPING AND PLANNING (SMP) ACTIVITIES IN  
THE FORESTLAND MANAGEMENT PROJECT (FMP) SITES  
IN DENR REGION III**

This Technical Bulletin is supplementary to the Joint FMB-PAWB Technical Bulletin No. 2013-01 on the "Implementation Guidelines for the Conduct of Survey, Mapping and Planning (SMP) activities in Forestland Management Project (FMP) Sites in Region III", particularly item *IV. General Provisions on the Issuance of Tenurial Instruments*.

This supplementary guidelines is being issued to address the presence of informal settlers who would not qualify as tenured migrants within the Pantabangan-Carranglan Watershed Forest Reserve, an FMP Project site in Region 3. This is based on the result of the Survey and Registration of Protected Area Occupants (SRPAO).

FMP development activities would be carried out on sites that overlap with areas that are meant to be awarded to PACBRMA holders. Since there are informal settlers who would not qualify as tenured migrants within the areas to be covered by the PACBRMA, then the following may apply:

1. Holders of Certificate of Ancestral Domain Title (CADT) who are interested may be engaged in FMP site development activities in accordance with existing Ancestral Domain Sustainable Development and Protection Plan (ADS DPP);
2. PACBRMA holders may enter into agreements with other legal entities within the FMP subproject sites to effectively implement the Community Resource Management Plan (CRMP) under the PACBRMA. Members of the legal entities, such as peoples' organizations (POs), should have been recorded as settlers based on the results of the SRPAO,

The Regional Office is advised to issue the corresponding Regional Technical Bulletin to operationalize the above guidelines at the Field Implementing Units (FIUs) level.

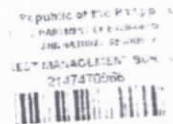
