PCSD RESOLUTION NO. 14-513

DECLARING CERTAIN AREAS IN BARANGAYS POBLACION, SANTO TOMAS, BOHOL AND SAN JUAN IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DUMARAN IN THE PROVINCE OF PALAWAN AS CRITICAL HABITAT PURSUANT TO REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9147 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE WILDLIFE RESOURCES CONSERVATION AND PROTECTION ACT OF 2001

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2001, Republic Act 9147, otherwise known as the "Wildlife Resources Conservation and Protection Act of 2001" was approved, Section 4 thereof defines that the respective jurisdiction conferred to DENR and DA is vested with the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD) pursuant to Republic Act 7611;

WHEREAS, Section 25 of RA 9147 specifically provides for the designation of critical habitats outside protected areas under RA 7586 and such designation shall be made on the basis of the best scientific data taking into consideration species endemism and/or richness, presence of man-made pressures/threats to the survival of wildlife living in the area, among others;

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2003, the PCSD passed Resolution No. 03-216, approving the DENR-DA-PCSD "Joint Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) pursuant to Republic Act 9147", Section 25 thereof provides for the designation of critical habitats outside protected areas;

WHEREAS, on July 29, 2011, the PCSD issued Administrative Order No. 12, otherwise known as "Detailed Guidelines in the Implementation of R.A. 9147 and its IRR as May be Made Applicable in the Province of Palawan"; Section 50 of which stipulates the designation of critical habitats in the province of Palawan which shall be governed by subsequent regulation to be promulgated for the purpose;

WHEREAS, on August 2, 2013, PCSD Resolution No. 13-481 was passed prescribing the guidelines for the establishment and management of critical habitats;

WHEREAS, Section 4 of PCSD Resolution No. 13-481 enumerates the procedures in the establishment of critical habitats and specifically provides that after declaration of an area as critical habitat by the PCSD, the concerned LGU shall include the declared area into the ECAN Map and Municipal Comprehensive Land and Water Use Plan (MCLWUP) after the area has been marked on the ground using permanent markers;

WHEREAS, on May 29, 2014, the PCSD Executive Committee approved the Dumaran Critical Habitat in favor of the Municipality of Dumaran and Katala Foundation Inc., more particularly described as follows:

WHEREAS, the Dumarán Critical Habitat shall be managed jointly by the Local Government Unit of the Municipality of Dumarán, Palawan and Katala Foundation, Inc, under the supervision of the PCSD pursuant to the above-cited PCSD Resolution No. 13-481; and for this purpose a Critical Habitat Management Plan (CHMP) shall be jointly developed by the said entities for review and approval of the PCSD;

WHEREAS, the above-cited approval of the Executive Committee is being presented for the confirmation of the Council *en banc* in accordance with existing rules and regulations;


WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises and on motion duly seconded, the Council resolves to confirm, as it is hereby **CONFIRMED THE APPROVAL OF CERTAIN AREAS IN BARANGAYS POBLACION, SANTO TOMAS, BOHOL AND SAN JUAN IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DUMARAN IN THE PROVINCE OF PALAWAN AS CRITICAL HABITAT PURSUANT TO R.A. 9147 OR WILDLIFE RESOURCES CONSERVATION AND PROTECTION ACT OF 2001**;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished the DENR, DA and other concerned agencies for their information and guidance;

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copy of this resolution be filed with the Office of the National Administrative Registrar at the UP Law Center for publication in accordance with existing rules.
