TERMS OF REFERENCE

PROCUREMENT FOR THE SERVICES OF AN INDIVIDUAL CONSOLIDATOR - WRITER OF THE PROTECTED AREA SUITABILITY ASSESSMENT REPORT FOR THE VERDE ISLAND PASSAGE (VIP)

I. Background

The Biodiversity Management Bureau (BMB) of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources is currently spearheading the establishment of the Verde Island Passage as a Protected Area under Republic Act No. 7586 or the National Integrated Protected Areas System (NIPAS) Act of 1992 as amended by Republic Act 11038 or the Expanded NIPAS (ENIPAS) Act of 2018. This is in line with our mandate in establishing and managing protected areas and our commitment to strengthening the management and protection of Verde Island as one of our priority areas for conservation. A Write Shop for the CALABARZON and MIMAROPA Protected Area Suitability Assessment (PASA) Report was conducted on November 28-29, 2023. The BMB-CMD is currently reviewing submitted PASA reports of the two (2) Regional Offices as to their contents and completeness based on the BMB Technical Bulletin No. 2016-04 entitled "Clarifying the Procedural Guidelines in the Conduct of PASA".

Along this line, and considering the urgency of the task, the BMB intends to procure the services of a consultant to consolidate and write the PASA report for the VIP.

II. Objectives

The engagement of the Consultant is necessary to expedite the consolidation and writing of the PASA Report for the Verde Island Passage in coordination with the BMB-Coastal and Marine Division, DENR CALABARZON, and MIMAROPA.

III. Scope of Work

The scope of work of this Terms of Reference would require a level of expertise and attention beyond the optimum in-house capability of the Biodiversity Management Bureau and is consistent with the Government's policy not to compete with the private sector, under Item no. 2 of Annex B of the 2016 IRR of R.A. 9184.

The Consultant shall report to the Director of the BMB. He/she shall work closely with the Coastal and Marine Division (CMD) and shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- Review the PASA Report of DENR CALABARZON and MIMAROPA including the result of the review of the BMB-CMD on the commonalities and differences between the two (2) PASA reports;
- Consolidate and write the reports of the DENR CALABARZON, and MIMAROPA into VIP PASA Report following the based on BMB Technical Bulletin No. 2016-04 entitled, "Clarifying the Procedural Guidelines in the Conduct of PASA";
- 3. Convene a meeting with BMB, DENR CALABARZON, and MIMAROPA to consult/discuss and solicit inputs/comments for the VIP PASA Report;

- 4. Integrate inputs/comments to improve/refine the draft PASA Report for the Verde Island Passage; and
- 5. Submit a finalized PASA Report for the Verde Island Passage.

IV. Deliverables

- Final PASA Report of the Verde Island Passage in hard copy and Google Drive link for the soft copy of the said PASA Report of the Verde Island Passage;
- 2. Report of the consultation meeting with BMB, DENR CALABARZON, and MIMAROPA.

V. Minimum Qualification and Requirements:

- 1. A bachelor's degree in communication arts, journalism, or any related course;
- 2. At least two (2) years of work experience in writing and editing, reports preferably technical reports;
- 3. Previous work with government agencies involved in the environment and natural resources sector in the country, especially in the coastal and marine sector is an advantage;
- 4. Highly organized, takes initiative, and works independently, creatively, and innovatively:
- 5. Proficient in written and spoken Filipino and English.

VI. Timetable

The Consolidator-Writer is expected to submit the deliverables within 15 days commencing upon signing of the contract.

VII. Contract Price and Schedule of Payments with Deliverables

The contract price is all-inclusive, fixed, and output-based regardless of any extension of the specified duration. The Contractor/Consultant shall receive SIXTY THOUSAND peso payments (PHP 60,000.00), inclusive of taxes based on the following tranches and deliverables:
