One of the objectives of the RA 9147 is to regulate the collection and trade of wildlife. Under Section 24 Conservation Breeding or Propagation of Threatened Species of the RA 9147, conservation breeding and propagation of threatened species shall be encouraged in order to enhance its population in its natural habitat. Under the same Section, commercial breeding or propagation of threatened species may be allowed provided that minimum requirements are met by the applicant, such as a) proven effective breeding and captive management techniques of the species; and, b) commitment to undertake commercial breeding in accordance with Section 17 of RA 91247, simultaneous with conservation breeding. For this purpose, the Secretary shall prepare a list of threatened species for commercial breeding.

**2. OBJECTIVE OF REGULATORY ACTION**

To develop a draft DAO on the list of threatened species of wild animals that will be allowed by the DENR for commercial propagation by private qualified individuals and providing guidelines thereof by end of CY 2024.
